

Manuals Adds an Arabic App

We are excited to announce that we published an Arabic app of consumer content at the end of June, bringing to 9 the number of languages The Manuals app is available in. The Merck Manuals is known as The MSD Manuals outside of the US and Canada.

The Arabic app was a particular challenge for our app development team, Sheryl Olinsky Borg, Associate Director, Translations and Apps, explained.

"Arabic is a right-to-left language, which means that the content and even the orientation of the navigation features is reversed from the English-language format. This can create challenges in designing digital products like The MSD Manuals Arabic Consumer app. The Digital Publishing team worked closely with translators and our app developer to ensure the app would be suitable for Arabic-language readers. The result is that over 300 million Arabic speakers around the world can now access The Manuals' trusted, high-quality content on their mobile devices."
